Tom Walker (Corps reg chief) mentioned he is also excited to get ILF going due to VDOT demands.... as they are looking at future needs and there is not enough credits.

Can you look at the provisions for VDOT service areas - as i thought for linear projects - they have a much less restrictive service area... so perhaps for VDOT we could offer them a lower ratio on price and get them credits in rivershed... say its 1.3x (vs 2 or 3) to have them buy ILF from DEQ 3 years in advance.... when no credits or VARTF is available.
